

Tuition Waiver for Disabled Oregon Veterans APPLICATION

In recognition of the service and sacrifices of military service veterans, the college shall waive tuition (not covered by any other agency or government sponsored program) as follows:

- For veterans who are identified as 100 percent disabled as a result of military service; and
- Are residents of Oregon at the time of application for the waiver

The purpose of this waiver is to allow an Oregon Veteran the opportunity to earn his or her first associates degree. Therefore, the waiver is offered for up to two years of full-time attendance or a degree (which ever comes first). The waiver does not cover books, fees or other expenses.

Adequate documentation must be provided including proof of the Veteran's service (DD Form 214) and documentation of the Veteran's service connected disability rating as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Financial aid awards may be reduced by the use of this waiver. Continuation of tuition waiver benefits is subject to satisfactory academic progress.
